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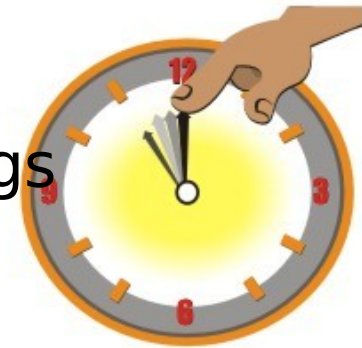
Home and School Partnership



- We believe that a strong partnership between home and school is in everyone's best interest and enables your child to have the best possible foundation for learning .

The basics ...

- ❑ The first year in school is known as Foundation Stage
- ❑ Three classes – Robins, Ducklings and Puffins
- ❑ School starts at 8.45am (gates open at 8.35am)
- ❑ School ends at 3.20pm Monday – Thursday
- ❑ School ends at 1.30pm on Friday

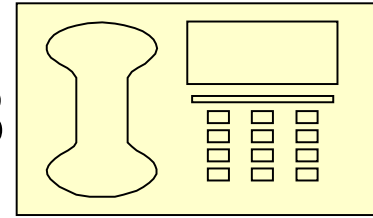


Organisation at beginning and end of the day...

- In the morning - the children enter through their classroom door where a member of staff will greet them.
- Please encourage independence and help your child to manage their own belongings.
- Home time routines – please collect your child from their classroom door where staff will safely hand them to you.
- We have an open door policy.

- Please ensure that your contact details are always up to date. We must have these details before the first visits to school.

- Reporting absence – Please phone school on a daily basis to let us know about your child’s absence. The school office will phone you daily if there is no call from you.
- Arriving late to school or collecting early for medical/dental appointments – Please inform the office beforehand and bring/email any appointment cards or letters.

Payments

Scopay

This is our on-line payment and booking system. You will be sent log in details shortly after your child starts school to access your account and download an app. This system is used for booking lunches and ordering or paying for anything in school.

Safety..



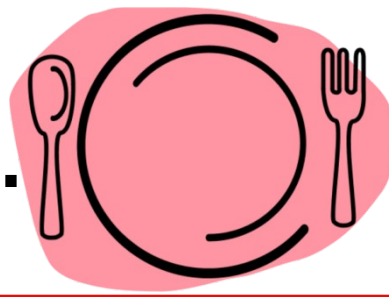
- Security - The gates are locked during the day.
- You must phone the office or inform your child's teacher if someone else is picking up your child from school to ensure their safety.
- Parental Support- DBS checks are carried out for all Parents and Grandparents who help at school.
- Cars can be parked at Morrison's Supermarket to increase safety outside the school.

Snack



- o Snack time held every morning.
- o Free healthy snack provided.
- o Children encouraged to try!
- o Free milk or water available.

Lunchtimes..



- We have a Gold Award for our school dinners.
- All infant children are provided with a free lunch.
- Variety of choices.
- Robust system for allergies – please put details on induction paperwork.
- Menus are found and ordered online.
- There is no need to remember what has been ordered as staff have a daily list.

Breakfast Club and After School



- Haydonleigh Breakfast Club is run by school staff.
- Registration forms can be found on our website.
- The children must be registered beforehand and dates booked in advance.
- Each session costs £3.00 (childcare vouchers accepted)
- The earliest drop off time is 7.45am.
- After School Clubs are run by Little Pippins (Green Meadow). Children are collected from school. The Clubs close at 6pm.

Medical issues..



- Medical problems and allergies should be noted on your child's contact form.
- Care plans are written with our school nurse and school staff where specific medical needs are identified.
- Medicines can only be given in school if they are clearly labelled and paper work completed.
- Asthmatic children must have an up to date blue inhaler at school and a spacer if they use one. Spare inhalers held in school for emergencies.
- Pink slips for accidents at school.
- Text message for head bumps.
- Sickness bugs.

- Enter through the **Westfield Way** entrance for the visits
- Children do not need to wear uniform

- Final visit will be with their teacher and class mates

Book Bags and Water Bottles



- All children will need a book bag (not a school rucksack)
- Please bring each day
- These can be ordered via Scopay (not needed on first day)
- Children may choose to bring a **named** water bottle
- Please only fill with water
- Please do not put into book bags

PE Kits



- Children will not need their PE kit in school on the first day in September. We will let you know when we need them.
- A school PE bag can be purchased via Scopay.
- Children wear house team colour t shirts for PE.
- You will be told your child's House Team in July.
- **PLEASE NAME EVERYTHING!**

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Getting ready for school over the Summer..



- Talk to your child about school, their visits, their friends and their teacher.
- Be positive about school and talk about all the fun they will have at school learning new things and meeting new friends.
- Encourage them to follow your rules and praise them for their efforts!
- Encourage them to be independent when using the toilet or getting dressed and undressed.
- Ask them to help you to tidy up and encourage them to make choices.
