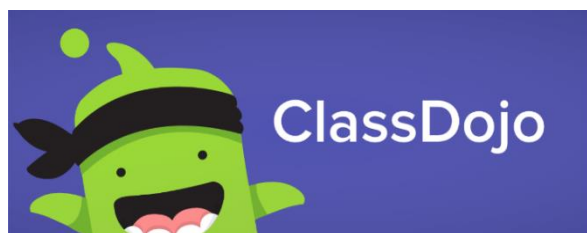
Catch-Up Clinics
