Earlier this term, our new caterer, Stir Food, ran a teddy bear lunch and the children took part in an art competition. Congratulations to our two winners:



Safeguarding

Tracking devices like AirTags and SmartTags were created to help people find lost items, but they can also be misused. Because they are small and easy to hide, they can sometimes be used to track someone without them knowing. This can lead to worrying situations, including bullying or unwanted attention.

This guide explains why these Bluetooth trackers are becoming more common, how they are sometimes misused, and what signs to look out for if a child may be affected. It also includes practical tips on how to check for hidden devices, which apps can help, and how to have open conversations with children. It's an important read for parents, carers and school staff who want to stay informed and keep children safe.
