

TikTok is one of the most popular apps for children and teenagers, with an endless stream of short, entertaining videos. However, it can also expose young people to things that aren't appropriate for their age. This might include upsetting content, risky "viral" challenges, misleading information or content that could influence them in worrying ways.

This guide explains the main risks to look out for, such as in-app spending, too much screen time and privacy issues. It also gives clear, practical tips to help parents and teachers make sure children use TikTok in a fun, positive

and—most importantly—safe way.
