Phonics

Reception have learnt the sounds sh (shell), th (thumb), ng (ring) and nk (pink). They have also learnt the new tricky words- she, push, he and of.

Year One have learnt the new sounds- e-e (these), oo/yoo/ew (chew/new), ie/ee (shield), or/aw (claw). They have also learnt the tricky words- house, mouse, water and want.

Maths

Reception have been learning about the values of UK coins, making amounts up to 10p and doing some shopping.

Year One have been looking at addition and subtraction, counting on or back 1/2/3 and beginning to add three small numbers together by spotting bonds to 10 or doubles (1-6).


