Reminder

Phonics

Reception have learnt the following new sounds - ff, ll, ss and j. They have also learnt the tricky words pull, full, put and as.

Year One have learnt the new sounds/ spellings - ir (e.g. bird), ie (e.g. pie), ue (e.g. blue/ rescue) and u (e.g. unicorn). They have also learnt the new tricky words people, their, oh and your.

Maths

Reception have been exploring length and height, using the language associated with comparing and measuring. They also began to explore capacity using the terminology 'empty', 'half-full' and 'full'. They compared the capacities of different containers and explored capacities through play.

Year One have focussed on the teen numbers, partitioning these numbers into the ten and the 1's, ordering these numbers and identifying which numbers are bigger and smaller. We also worked on ordinal numbers and enjoyed running races in the playground and handing out 'place' stickers.

Tables next week are the 9x. Homework will resume next week (14th Nov). Our new topics are on the website. We will be looking at materials in science and the lives of Queen Elizabeth I, Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth II in history.
