Year 1 Keep practising play words in a big loud voice!

Phonics

Reception have learnt the sounds v, w, x and y. They have practised recognising these sounds and reading words containing them e.g. vet, win, fix and yap. They have also learnt the tricky words and, has, his and her.

They have also continued to practise oral blending such as Simon Says ('can you touch your ch-i-n/ h-ea-d/ l-i-p).

Year One have focussed on the following: oa/ o (e.g. go) / igh / i (e.g. tiger) / ai / a (e.g. paper) and ee / e (e.g. he). They have also learnt the tricky words - Mr, Mrs, Ms and ask.

Maths

Reception have been focussing on counting. They have been chanting numbers to 20 and beginning to chant numbers to 100. They have been counting 10 items into a set and are beginning to count up to 20 items into a set. They have been matching spoken numbers and written numerals to appropriate quantities. They have worked hard to count accurately using 1:1 correspondence and practised writing numbers to 10.

Year One have revised bonds to 5, 6 and 10, found pairs which make 7, used addition facts for 5, 6 and 10 to solve subtractions and used number facts for 5, 6 and 10 to solve word problems.
