It was lovely to have all of our new Reception children in school on Tuesday. We had a fabulous morning and are looking forward to them starting in September.

Well done to everyone for their amazing performances at Sports Day today. I am always delighted to see the fantastic attitudes that our children show – whether first or last, they all give their best. Thanks to all of the families and friends that were there to cheer the teams on and help set up/bring things back to school. Year 6 were super helpers and great company at the first aid table! Thanks to their parents for the ice lollies at the end of the event – a welcome treat.

Next week the Year 6 children are going to their new settings for transition days and we hope that they all have a great time.

On Monday we will spend time in our classes for next year. Children should go to their normal room for registration. Then Year 1 will go in to Mrs Gibbins and Year 3 will go to join Mrs Pickles and Mr Wilkinson. They will not need to bring anything different with them.

End of year reports will be sent home next week with the children. As these reports are quite detailed we don't have a formal parents' evening. However, if you have something specific that you would like to discuss with the class teacher please contact the office.

Year 6 parents – as you may have seen the SATS results will now not be available to schools until 16th July! We will therefore send reports without this information and those results will be sent home as soon as we receive them.

This service is led by our Year 6 children and everyone is welcome to join us, there will be laughs and tears as we say goodbye to these amazing children and their families. Homework Year 1**

We have our final spelling test on Tuesday and there will be no more homework this year. Thank you so much to all families for your support with reading, practising spellings and consolidating maths concepts over the year. It really does make a huge difference to the learning.

Phonics

Reception have been reading longer words and words ending in s and es. They also continued to recap previously taught tricky words and sounds.

Year One will now be revising all taught sounds and words for the rest of the term.

Maths

Reception have been practising number bonds/ partitioning to 5, 6 and 10, sorting objects into 2 groups, finding different combinations making these totals. They matched and wrote down the additions to match the combinations they found e.g. $5+1=6$ / $6+4=10$ / $3+2=5$. They also practised counting on and back 1, 2, 3 or 4 from numbers up to 20.

Year One have been locating 2 digit numbers on a 100 square, ordering numbers to 100, identifying 10s and 1s in 2 digit numbers and saying and writing 1 more and 1 less and 10 more and 10 less than any number to 100. They have been exploring patterns in 10's, 5's and 2's and counting in tens from any given number.

Mrs Gibbins – Green class

If you have any old boxes we can use to finish our photo frames they will be gratefully received. They need to be easy to cut with scissors.

This week is the last homework.

Today was the last spelling test. So no more for the rest of term.

Mrs Pickles/Mr Wilkinson – Blue Class

Please ensure that you check and sign your child's homework diary each week.

Times tables: We are going to have a go at some more challenging tables for years 5 and 6. These will involve partitioning and then combining the answers e.g. $23 \times 6 = (20 \times 6) + (3 \times 6) = 138$.

Year 4 will continue with all tables up to 12×12 in the inverse, e.g. $96 \div 12 = 8$, $35 \div 5 = 7$.

GPS and Maths homework:

There will be no more homework or spelling tests for the rest of this term. Thank you for your support in ensuring that your child has completed their homework activities for this year.

The children will still be expected to read every day and record this in their homework diary.
