Mrs Truslove/Mrs Banks – Red class

Our topic this term is Polar Explorers/ Snow and Ice. If your child has anything at home related to this topic they are more than welcome to bring it in to share with the class to support our learning.

Reminder: Forest School is every Tuesday and rarely cancelled due to weather! Please make sure that children have lots of warm and weatherproof layers.

Phonics

Reception have learnt the new sounds ai, ee, igh and oa. They have practised reading and writing words containing these sounds.

All reception children will be coming home with a 'Tricky Word' bookmark over the next couple of weeks. The bookmark will contain words we have taught in school which they need to learn. These words are 'tricky' because they cannot be sounded out and must just be learnt from sight. Once your child can read these words (in and out of order) they will receive the next bookmark with new words to learn. Please practise these at home as much as possible. Thank you.

Year One have learnt the following alternative sounds/ spellings- /e/ ea eg head, /w/ wh eg wheel and /oa/ oe ou eg toe, shoulder. They have also learnt the tricky words any, many and again.

Maths

Reception- This week the children have practised counting to 100 and comparing and ordering numbers to 20. They have had a lot of practise subitising numbers to 6. They have also been estimating numbers of objects and images and understanding that teen numbers are 10 plus some more.

Year One- This week the children have been practising saying the number one more or one less and two more or two less using a number line or 100 square. They have also been locating 2-digit numbers and understanding them as some tens and some ones.

Mrs Gibbins – Green class

Our topics this term include

- The Great Fire of London,
- Habitats

- The children have stuck their new spelling lists into their reading records.
- This week the tables are the 2x.
- Homework is in the blue book.

We have started our Forest school work. It is very chilly so remember to wrap up. Times tables: Year 4 return to the 4x table.

Yr4: Maths: Worksheet on Tenths on Number Lines and Rounding decimals.

English: 3 pages in the CGP book on Confusing Words (p.32-34).
