Homework

On Monday Year 1 will bring home their first homework. There will be a simple maths task and spellings to learn. The first spelling check will be the following Monday and is a written check. The maths task is based on our current learning and the spellings based on our phonic teaching for the week so should not prove too difficult. We also ask that children read regularly and that this is recorded in their record books. Thanks for your support.

Phonics

Reception have been practising oral segmenting and blending through fun games such as Simon Says e.g. Simon Says can you out your hands on your 'l-e-g'/ 'n-e-ck'?

Year One have been revisiting the previously taught sounds and tricky words and reading words such as lights, sighing and mixes.

Maths

Reception have been singing lots of number rhymes, noticing patterns, learning about 5 frames and doing lots of subitising (knowing how many without counting e.g. dice patterns).

Year One have been subitising, counting, recognising, ordering and writing numbers to 20 (with the correct formation).

Nature collections

In Art this term we are learning all about using natural items to create art work/ sculptures. We will be learning about the artist Andy Goldsworthy. If you are going on a walk over the weekend, please collect any natural items such as acorns, pine cones, conkers, leaves, feathers, twigs, stones and bring them into school! We will be using these to create our own nature artwork. Thank you.

English: 2 pages in the Grammar book on verbs and adverbs (p.5&9).


Yr4: Maths: 2 activities on Mathletics on Place Value.
