Year 6 parents – as you may have seen the SATS results will now not be available to schools until 16th July! We will therefore send reports without this information and those results will be sent home as soon as we receive them.

On Monday we are going on our trip to the cinema to see Minions and Monsters. We will have popcorn at the cinema and water is provided. Times tables: We are going to have a go at some more challenging tables for years 5 and 6. These will involve partitioning and then combining the answers e.g. $23 \times 6 = (20 \times 6) + (3 \times 6) = 138$.

Year 4 will continue with all tables up to 12x12 in the inverse, e.g. $96 \div 12 = 8$, $35 \div 5 = 7$.

There will be **no more homework** or spelling tests for the rest of this term. Thank you for your support in ensuring that your child has completed their homework activities for this year.

The children will still be expected to **read every day and record** this in their homework diary.
