Phonics

Reception have learnt the new sounds g, o, c, and k. They have been reading words containing these sounds, practising oral blending and segmenting and writing these sounds using the correct letter formation. They have also learnt the tricky word- is.

Year One have been reviewing the alternative spellings they have been taught (ay, ea, oy, ou). They have also practised reading longer words containing these sounds.

Maths

Reception have been learning about the days of the week, reciting the names and beginning to order them. They have been using language related to time such as yesterday, today, tomorrow, morning, afternoon, evening and night. They looked at o'clock times in the context of their daily routine. Finally they were introduced to the language of position, playing hide and seek with 'Dave' (our 'naughty' dragon) using key vocabulary such as in, on, over, under, beside, left and right.

Year One have been reading and writing numbers and number names to 20. They compared and ordered numbers to 20, identifying 1 more and 1 less. They have been estimating sets of objects, counting to check and ordering sets according to size, understanding 0 as the empty set.

Next week in maths we will be continuing to work on multiplication and moving onto division.
