J'apprends le français (1)

Lesson objectives

To introduce the Francophone world and French as a subject to the children.

Graded Activities

- Explain aim of the unit: to have a better understanding of France and the French speaking world and to learn how to say some basic phrases in French e.g., greetings, how they are feeling, what their name is, numbers 1-10 and colours.

5 mins

- Using the 'J'apprends le français (1)' PowerPoint, start the lesson. The children will be exposed to very little of the foreign language in this lesson, as the aim of this week is to broaden their cultural awareness and to provide them with a bit of context before the language learning journey begins. 25 mins

PLENARY: Can the children remember from memory at least one city (apart from Paris) that they saw on the map? If not, what can they do during the week to make sure they know at least one other city?

Resources required

- PowerPoint.
- French cities map worksheet.
- Map of France for the classroom.

Suggested consolidation exercises/games/songs

- Draw and label a map of France and/or the Francophone world for a wall display.
- Topic work on a French city, researching landmarks, facts and figures.
- Discuss the other languages spoken at home by the children and create a wall chart.
