<p><b>Body</b></p>	<p><b>The body is a collection of amazing parts, like organs (like the heart, lungs, and brain) and systems (like the digestive system or the skeleton), all working together like a well-organised team.</b></p>

<b>Human</b>	<b>All people are humans, men, women and children. We are animals that walk on two legs and speak using words. Senses Our senses tell our bodies about things around us by seeing, hearing, smelling, tasting or feeling.</b>
<b>Mammal</b>	<b>A mammal is a warm-blooded vertebrate (an animal with a backbone) that has hair or fur and feeds its young with milk.</b>
<b>Warm blooded</b>	<b>Warm-blooded animals are those which can naturally regulate their own body temperatures.</b>
<b>Skin</b>	<b>Skin is the outer covering of humans and all other animals with a backbone. It protects the body from germs, injuries, and extremes of hot or cold.</b>
<b>Senses</b>	<b>Humans have five senses that help us to learn about the world around us.</b>
