### Whole School

At Brook Field, we're committed to supporting our pupils' health, wellbeing and readiness to learn. Milk plays an important role in helping children stay nourished and focused throughout the school day. However, under current rules, children lose access to free school milk when they turn five – meaning some pupils stop receiving milk partway through their Reception year.

We're supporting the Fair Milk for a Fair Start campaign, which is calling for a simple change so all children can receive free milk until the end of Reception.
