Whole School

We are noticing an increase in cars driving onto the school site in the morning to drop children off before school. We do understand that some people face time pressures in the mornings to drop children then go straight to work, but the car park has a very limited capacity, and there will be times when we have to prevent cars from entering in order to maintain the safety of all site users. If a member of staff asks you not to enter, we would ask you to respect their judgement of the situation and to go elsewhere to park safely and walk back to school. Please do not wait in your car by the gate as this causes congestion on Cartwright Drive endangering all other road users.

We will always aim to allow blue badge holders to drive onto site, but other cars can currently only be allowed if there is room for everyone to park and manoeuvre safely. The safety of everyone walking on and near the school site is paramount.

Over the two next weeks, we will be closely monitoring the situation to determine if we need to implement any revised measures consistently to ensure everyone's safety
