#### Foundation Stage

The children in Foundation Stage have achieved 20 marbles in their classroom jar. On Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March we will be holding a 'marble party' for both FS classes in the afternoon.

### Year 1

Year 1 have earned enough marbles for a marble party on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March. Please may your child bring in a labelled special snack to have during the party. Your child will still need a healthy snack for playtime.

The last forest school is Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> March for this term. Please collect your child's wellies from outside Miss Webb's classroom. If your child has done forest school this year, please check to see if they have been left.

### Year 2

We would kindly remind you to continue to support your child in learning to tie their laces, particularly if they are wearing laced trainers on P.E. Days. Thank you.

As we reach this point in the year, we find that the majority of children have completed the Monster Phonics program and passed the phonics assessments. Therefore, Guided Reading will be changing to Whole Class Guided Reading, until Summer Term 2. This means that the whole class will be reading the same book, with each child reading once a week, aloud to the rest of the class and then answering questions about the text. This will be recorded in their Reading Record book, as per usual. We have left access to Monster Phonics eBooks available for you to choose to read with your child. They will also be coming home with books from outside the Year 2 classroom. They will choose 2 books to take home. These will be in addition to the Quality Parent Share books. It is your child's responsibility to change these books as they finish reading them, during EMT time. Do please remind them. We hope your children enjoy reading these books.

### Year 3

We are walking to Holy Trinity Shaw Church on Friday morning. Please ensure that your child has weather appropriate outdoor clothing with them as we will be going whatever the weather. We will be back at school in time for lunch.

### Year 4
