## Uniform Policy

### INTRODUCTION

It is recommended that all children at Brook Field will wear school uniform as it helps to create a sense of community and establish a working environment. A school uniform also removes distraction, which may be caused by an individual's style of dress and allows pupils to concentrate on learning. The suggested uniform, which is to be clearly labelled with the child's name on, is as follows:

- Black or grey trousers, (no jeans) skirts or pinafores
- White shirt, blouse
- White or red polo shirt
- Red sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece
- Sensible flat black shoes (no trainers), flat ankle boots or sandals with socks.
- Red check summer dresses/red polo shirt dresses
- Black or grey shorts, trousers (no jeans) or skirts
- Hat or cap



No nail varnish or jewellery (except for stud earrings) should be worn to school. Hair accessories must be kept to a minimum and unobtrusive.

### PE Kit

- T-shirt in house colour
- Black shorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms
- Daps or Trainers (predominantly black or white)
- The children must wear their school jumper or school fleece (no other colour jumpers or hoodies)
