Welcome to our new parents – we hope your children are settling into their new school routine and making new friends! CLESA is our PTA, a registered charity which raises money for the benefit of children at both Chestnut Lane & Elangeni Schools. All parents become automatic members of CLESA when they join the schools. We held our AGM on Thursday 13 October where we discussed plans for the upcoming year. We are really delighted that volunteers have come forward to run the **Family Fun Night & Elangeni Disco**, along with a **Quiz/Curry Night** for parents next term. These have not been held since before lockdown & are likely to be popular events so look out for future CLESA communications on how to book tickets!

Our treasurer, Laura Chinnakone, covered the finances for the last FY ending August 2022. Laura announced we raised a fantastic £17,906 over the year - see overleaf for a breakdown of money raised. We also heard how schools have been spending CLESA money, directly benefiting our children. Over the last year, Chestnut Lane School spent £12,536 on Early Years ICT equipment, a library audit & new library books, traffic calming signs on Chestnut Lane and a Year 2 leavers' disco. Elangeni School spent £8,532 on workshops for all year groups, playground equipment, benches, cameras & a portable speaker. We were also really excited to hear from the Head Teachers about their spending plans for the upcoming year — including a new gazebo that has been installed in Elangeni's playground! Do look out for it next time you are at the school!
