# WHAT HAVE WE BEEN LEARNING THIS HALF-TERM?

## **MATHS**

Butterfly and Ladybird classes have done lots of very clever maths learning. They have been singing number rhymes, which helps the children to learn to say number names in order, and to count accurately a small set of objects or people. They have also been finding out all about 'more' and 'fewer'. They collected sets of objects to compare, and found out when 2 sets are the same.













# **ROUTINES**

Children in all classes have been learning to follow our routines in school and have been exploring all of the different areas inside and outside. Tidying resources away is an important thing to learn in school and the children are doing so well. They have been taught the phrase 'choose it, use it, put it away' to remind them what to do. Try it at home, they're really good at being super helpers! They have also been learning to share toys and resources and to take turns with other children.











# **FOOTBALL SKILLS**

Coach Abbey has been working with Butterfly and Ladybird class children every week. She has been teaching them to follow her instructions, move in different ways, throw, catch and dribble small and large balls.
