

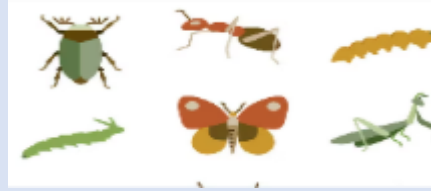

Classification and changing habitats

We will be learning how to group animals and plants in various ways.

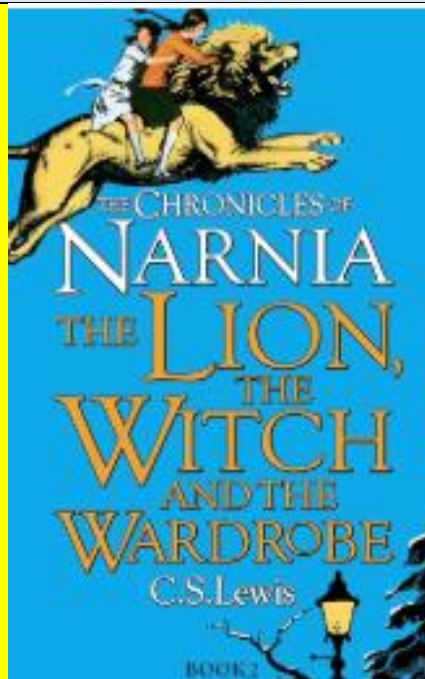


Geography

Our Geography topic is, 'What are rivers and how are they used?' We will be learning about rivers; their place in the water cycle and the names and locations of major rivers.



In English, we will be basing our reading and writing lessons on the classic story: Lion the Witch and the Wardrobe by C.S Lewis. We will explore how a writer develops personality and feelings, how characters are developed through speech and write for different purposes. Children will continue to develop their grammatical understanding. We will continue to have a writing lesson every day and a Reading lesson four times each week.

Our PE lessons are Athletics (outdoor adventurous activities) and cricket. The children will continue to have two lessons each week, on Wednesday and Thursdays. PE lessons on Wednesdays will be taught by Mrs Holland and on Thursdays by Mr Cowper.



In RE, our key question to explore this half term is:

Did Jesus really do miracles? Through this study, children will explore at least two miracles of Jesus and evaluate from the view of a believer and a sceptic. They will show an understanding of some reasons why people do, or do not, believe in the miracle of Jesus.
