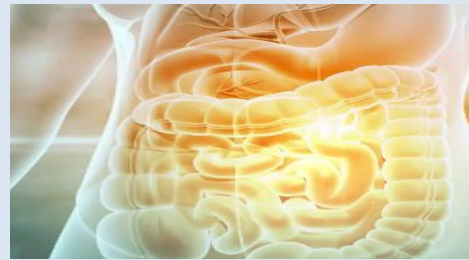

Digestion and Food.**

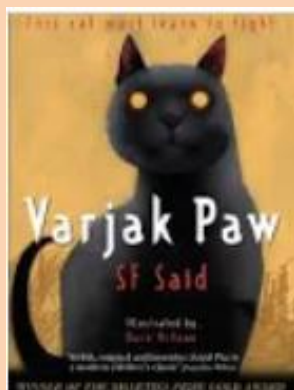
We will be exploring the role of the digestive system and comparing teeth and diets of different animals as part of a food chain.



Geography – Where does our Food Come From? We will be finding out about where our food comes from and exploring how our food choices impact the environment and what it means to trade responsibly.

Our key Math's learning:

- Represent and partition numbers up to 10,000
- Find 1, 10, 100, 1000 more or less
- Estimate
- Compare
- Round numbers
- Add and subtract 4-digit numbers
- Times tables, including the 3s, 4s, 6s and 8s

In English, we will link our learning to Varjak Paw. A variety of writing genres will be explored alongside the text, including, letters and diary entries.

Each week, we will have four Reading lessons alongside our daily English writing lessons and 5 spelling lessons. We will consolidate the Year 3 English learning and Grammar content.

In Year 4, the children will have a statutory multiplication test in the Summer Term. The expectation is that children by the end of Year 4 will know all of their times tables up to 12x12. Over the year, we will increase our fluency with the times tables. Children will have a 30-minute weekly TT Rockstars session in our ICT suite to login and play. This will continue to secure their fluency with the multiplication facts, and associated division facts.

Our PE lessons are basketball and cross country. Our PE days are Tuesday and Thursday.
