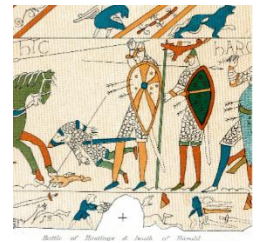

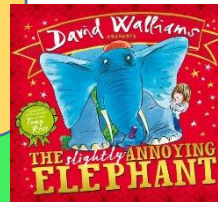

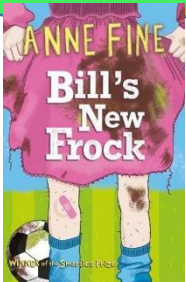
Plants and Plant Growth

In Science, the children will learn about what seeds need to grow and how they germinate. They will carry out comparative tests, investigate the conditions for seed germination, measure stem height with rulers and record their findings.



English

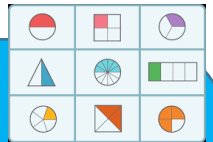


WE LOVE TO READ!

Maths
