Exploring the relationship between viscosity and the flow of liquids through scientific enquiry.

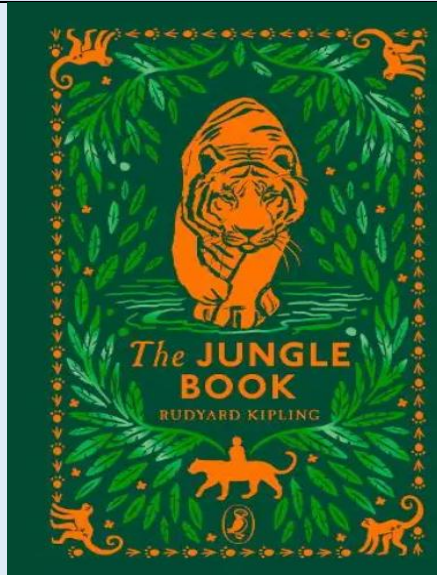


History

In English, we will be basing our reading and writing lessons on the classic story: The Jungle Book by Rudyard Kipling. We will explore how a writer develops personality and feelings, how characters are developed through speech and write for different purposes. Children will continue to develop their grammatical understanding. We will continue to have a writing lesson every day and a Reading lesson four times each week.
