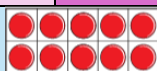


Our class text for English is 'The Man on the Moon' by Simon Bartram. We will be looking at setting and character descriptions and learning how to use expanded noun phrases, the correct tense and conjunctions in our writing. Children will write a descriptive piece about the man on the moon and a non-chronological report about the moon!

We will be learning how to count in 2's, 5's and 10's.



We will also be learning how to make and add equal groups, make arrays and double numbers.

Finding a half and a quarter will be a part of our fractions learning.



This term's PE will feature games using striking and fielding.



Science:
We will investigate plants. How to label their different parts, recall some roles of a flowering plant, name wild and garden plants and deciduous and evergreen trees. We will learn that seeds and bulbs come from plants and know that seeds need water for growth.



Computing:
We will be typing on a keyboard and using tools to change the look of our writing.



We will show children how to use TTRS to learn the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.

Geography:
What is it like to live in Shanghai? We will learn about the human and physical features and draw a sketch map of their local area. We will name and locate some continents on a map where we will focus on Shanghai and what it is like to live there comparing it to a part of the UK.
