### Autumn 1 Curriculum Overview

River System

#### Autumn 1

Rivers

#### YEAR 5



#### English

We will be basing our learning around the text, 'Kensuke's Kingdom' by Michael Morpurgo.

Skills - the children will explore the themes in the text, looking in detail at the way language is used to develop character and to describe settings, mood and story.

#### Writing outcomes:

- ✓ Descriptive writing
- ✓ Recounts including diaries and letters
- Formal writing including a report and a balanced argument.

Spelling: re-capping the key words from the Year3 & 4 spelling list and starting the spelling patterns from Year 5.

Reading: during dedicated reading lessons we will be looking at a range of extracts and developing our retrieval and inference skills.

**Grammar:** recapping on some of the grammar aspects from year4 and then looking at expanded noun phrases, use of paragraphs and a range of punctuation.

#### Geography - Rivers and the water cycle

We will look at how rivers are formed and name and label different sections of the river. We will learn how rivers can change the land around them and how the water cycle works.

#### Children will:

- Use Atlas skills to find and research rivers in the world and UK
- Write and draw labelled diagrams.
- Give reasons for why things happen.

#### Science - Earth and Space

- Students will be taught to describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system.
- They will be able to describe the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth.

#### Music - Glockenspiel (metal xylophone)

Children will have the opportunity to play and sing solo or as part of a group. They will play tuned and untuned instruments.

#### Maths

#### Number and Place value:

- · Ordering and comparing numbers
- Number patterns and sequences

#### Calculations

- To know my times tables
- Mental and written methods for addition and subtraction including decimals and fractions.
- Multiply and divide using known facts and decimals.

#### Using and applying:

 Solving word problems with place value and calculation knowledge.

#### RE - Buddhism

This term we will look at Buddhism. We will understand the teachings of the Buddha and the impact they have made on the world. We will try to think what it means to be a Buddhist.

#### PSHE

We will be focusing on Health and Wellbeing this term. Children will explore the importance of nutrients and portion control. They will look at food labels and meal menus to decide which food is the healthiest.

#### PE - Team building and Empathy

Children will learn to communicate and develop skills to work in a team through games such as Tag rugby and Boccia

#### Spanish - All about me!


We will learn how to talk about myself and my family in Spanish.

#### Art & Design Technology

Our Artist this term is Beatriz Milhazes. We will study here work and use this as inspiration to make our own collages using a variety of textiles and materials.

## <u>Mornings</u>





School starts at 8.45am

8.30am and 8.45am.

# Reading





At West Acton Primary School, we value the importance of reading and we encourage a love of reading.

All pupils visit the school Library once a week to choose a book for reading pleasure.

We go to the Library on Fridays



All pupils will have a Home Reading Book for their book bag that matches their reading level and must be read everyday for homework for 20 minutes.

In Key Stage 2, they need to write their own comments and sign their Reading Records themselves. However, we ask that parents of children in Key Stage 2 still listen to their child read and comment and sign in Reading Records at least once a week.

Out of these sessions of reading we ask that pupils read online once a week, using Bug Club, to answer questions about what they have read.

This is checked weekly by school staff.



# KS2 Snacks



The only drink should be water or milk. The school will provide water for packed lunch pupils.

KS2 pupils should only have fruit or vegetables as snacks for break time – <u>do not</u> send anything else in for your child.

At home time, please **do not** give your child unhealthy snacks to eat whilst leaving school.




