

Reminders

School Meals/Breakfast Club

Please can we remind parents/carers that payment for school meals and breakfast club MUST be paid in advance on ParentPay. If payment for a school meal has not been received the school office will contact you to bring a packed lunch for your child/children. If you are experiencing particular difficulty regarding payment of dinner money, please speak to Mrs Collins or Mrs Murphy in confidence. Thank you

Achiever Assemblies

Building Fund

As a voluntary aided school, we have to pay 10% towards any capital building improvements to our school. To help towards these costs we ask for a contribution of £30.00 per family per academic year. In recent years this fundraising has supported the refurbishment of the Foundation Quad, the installation of bifold doors in the Foundation Unit and new windows in a section of the school. Your contribution can be paid as a one off payment of £30.00 on ParentPay or in smaller instalments. We really hope you can support us by making a contribution from your family to help us maintain the very best learning environment for our children.

Please note: Price increases with effect from 1st September 2024

School meal prices are increasing to £2.95
Breakfast club price is increasing to £4.50 (First Child) £4.00 (Sibling)
Walker service price has now increased to £10.00

After School Walker Service – Unfortunately, due to low numbers and increasing costs, the cost for our after-school walker service to Adwick Primary will increase to £10 per day from 2^{nd} June 2025. This cost is still subsidised and will be reviewed again if numbers increase on a regular basis.

IMPORTANT: We are a NUT FREE school. Please ensure you do no send your child with anything containing nut or nut traces, this includes peanut butter. Thank you

Hot food

Reminder - Pupils must not have hot food delivered or bring hot food to school in a thermos flask for food safety reasons. Schools catering have checks in place to monitor the temperature of their food and no other hot food can be consumed by pupils on the school premises. There is a choice of three hot school dinner options on a daily basis but, other than that, pupils must bring a cold packed lunch with them each day. Thank you.

<u>Important – Please read</u>

Dear Parents & Carers,

The Council has asked school to share the following information with you.

Parking on the 'School- Keep Clear' markings outside schools at drop-off and pick-up times is a safety issue for pupils.

As a result, Doncaster Council has decided to introduce camera enforcement to operate outside the following schools from the week beginning 15th September:

This is designed to promote a safer environment around school gates.

The cameras will be operated during school times only and will only be used for enforcement purposes on the keep clear restriction and any nearby clearway bus stops. Residential properties will be obscured with a filter and only trained Civil Enforcement Officers will have access to the footage.

It is hoped this will help create a safer environment around our schools.



Please ensure your child/children wear the correct uniform every day unless there are special circumstances such as non-uniform days.

Please Note: Sensible footwear should be worn. Footwear consisting of crocs/sliders/open toe sandals/flip flops are not allowed due to safety.

Spare, clean uniform will be provided for those who do not come to school in correct uniform.

After School Wrap Around Care – Adwick Primary School

Awaken Education currently run after school clubs and wrap around childcare at Adwick Primary School. We currently offer a 'Walker Service' to this provision.

From September 2025 they are looking at enhancing their provision to make more spaces available.

The after-school clubs run until 5:30pm, providing a safe and fun environment where children can enjoy sports, crafts, games, and themed activities every day and the clubs are timetabled each day to provide structure to the sessions.

To help them plan for the new academic year, they have asked us to consult our parents/carers families and ask you to complete a short expression of interest form if you would be interested in using their provision from September 2025. If there is sufficient interest, they may be able to look at extending their service to collect from our school which should help to reduce the cost to parents compared to our current Walker Service. <u>Important – please read</u>

The City of Doncaster Council have advised us that the Transitional Protection arrangements for those entitled to means-tested Free School Meals has come to an end as per the published Free school meals guidance.



Our understanding is as follows;

Newly entitled to FSM on or after 01/04/25

Any pupil who becomes newly entitled to FSM on or after 01/04/25 will only remain entitled for as long as they meet the eligibility criteria.

Primary schools; Pupils on FSM at 31/03/25 keep this entitlement to the end of year 6. **Moving from Year 6 to year 7;** When pupils move from year 6 to year 7, the Benefits Team will check entitlement and we will notify the Secondary schools of those children that are entitled to FSM in year 7.

IMPORTANT

Please note that pupils arriving on the school bus are not supervised and do not become the responsibility of the school until the morning bell goes. Whilst Mrs Murphy and Mr Kowalski are often on the playground in the morning before school, this is not always the case. Breakfast Club is open from 7:30am and is available for all year groups. Parents of pupils going home on the bus need to ensure they are at the stop on time to meet their child/children.
