



# Leave of Absence During Term Time

We would like to remind you that no leave of absence from school can be authorised unless due to exceptional circumstances; which are as follows-

- Where it is company/organisational policy for an employee to take leave at a specific time in the year and there is no opportunity for a family holiday in the school holidays. This must be evidenced by production of the policy document of the organisation.
- Service personnel returning from/scheduled to embark upon a tour of duty abroad.
- Where a holiday is recommended as part of a child's rehabilitation from a medical or emotional issue. Evidence must be provided.
