

Applications for secondary school for September 2026 are now available through the Doncaster Council admissions website. The closing date for secondary applications are 31st October 2025.



Important Information for Year 6

The national closing date for secondary school applications is 31st of October 2025; the announcement date is 2nd of March 2026. All applications made by this date will be considered together.

Applications received after the 31st of October will be dealt with after the offer day and if we never receive an application the child will be given a place at the nearest school with spaces. This may not be the child's catchment school.

PLEASE ensure that you have submitted your application by the deadline to ensure the best chance of securing your first choice schools.
