

School Uniform Policy

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All children are required to wear our school uniform every day.

Our uniform consists of:

- **RED** sweatshirt, cardigan, jumper
- **RED** fleece jacket (*optional*)
- WHITE polo shirt
- **NAVY** trousers, shorts, skirts or pinafore dresses.
- **RED** & WHITE gingham dress (*optional for Summer months*)
- Change of clothes for PE - t-shirt and shorts or leotard.
- Pumps or trainers will be required for outside PE in warmer weather.

My Clothing supplies our embroidered uniform items online. My Clothing has the added benefit of:

- a 5% cash donation to school
- free returns

Uniform is also available to buy at other outlets/supermarkets and does not have to be limited to the My Clothing website.

Pre-Loved Uniform Available

We understand how costly school uniforms can be and how fast our children grow and we hope our uniform requirements help to keep this to a minimum. We also wanted to let you know that we have a “Fully Loved” uniform rail available in the entrance to school which will also be available at our pre-visits. Here, you can find pre-loved, clean uniform which has been donated by parents when their child has outgrown these items. Parents can take any items they might need, even if just to use as spares. They can also then donate items back to us as their own child grows out of things.

Outdoor Wear

Children should always bring an outdoor coat to school in case of cold weather. The children are outside at morning break and lunchtime and may go outside as part of normal classroom activities.

Footwear

Children are not expected to change into different footwear for use indoors except in bad weather when a change is essential to keep the floor safe and dry and the children comfortable. We do, however, encourage sensible footwear at all times. Children will do indoor PE barefoot during the Winter months but you will be asked to provide a pair of trainers/pumps for outdoor PE when the weather improves.

Jewellery

The wearing of jewellery including earrings is discouraged and is not allowed at all during PE sessions. If your child's ears are newly pierced and the parent wishes the child to keep their earrings in for a while, then the child must bring plasters to school to cover the earrings. After six weeks, the child must remove and replace earrings themselves or not wear them on PE days.
