### Why give homework?

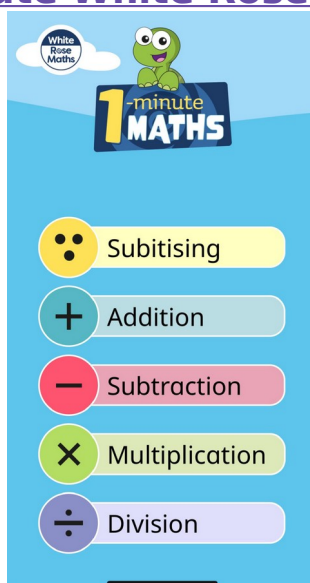
- It enables children to build on their prior learning and rehearse key skills at home whilst using some of our school values *Resilience* and *Challenge*.
