Children's Mental Health Week 9-13th February

Next week in school, we will be recognising the national event, **Children's Mental Health Week**. Children will take part in key stage appropriate assemblies, followed by class activities focused on the **Five Ways to Wellbeing**. Our School Council has chosen a special daily activity linked to **Connect, Be Active, Give, Keep Learning and Take Notice**. Each child will be then given a sticker – thank you to our PTA who have donated these.

Staff will support children to talk about big and small feelings in a safe, age-appropriate way, helping them understand the importance of looking after their mental wellbeing. We encourage families to continue these conversations at home and remind children that trusted adults are always there to listen.

You might want to ask the following questions:

- Who can you talk to if you're worried about something?
- What's one thing you noticed or enjoyed today?
