It has been another busy and exciting week across the school.

Our Year 2 children had a fantastic visit to Ashton Court Estate, where they explored the beautiful grounds and took part in outdoor learning activities linked to their current topics. The children represented the school brilliantly and particularly enjoyed observing nature and spending time learning outdoors.

Year 3 visited Redcatch Park and Community Garden as part of their geography work. During the visit, pupils carried out a survey linked to the new Broad Walk development, thinking carefully about how local areas change over time and how developments can impact communities. They asked thoughtful questions and showed excellent curiosity throughout the trip.

Our Year 4 pupils took part in the exciting Ashton Gate sports festival at Ashton Gate Stadium. The children demonstrated fantastic teamwork, determination and sportsmanship throughout the event.

Year 6 have continued preparing for the next stage of their education through a number of important transition activities. This week, pupils had the opportunity to meet teachers from their new secondary schools, helping them to feel more confident and excited about the move ahead. They have also visited the Life Skills Centre and took part in practical activities and discussions designed to support their growing independence.

We were also delighted to welcome our new Reception children onto the field this week ahead of their September start. It was lovely to see families meeting staff and beginning to build relationships with our school community. The children enjoyed exploring the outdoor space and we look forward to welcoming them back again soon.

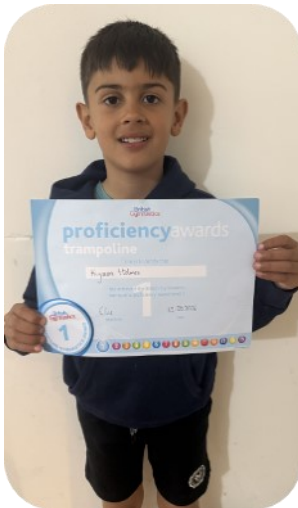

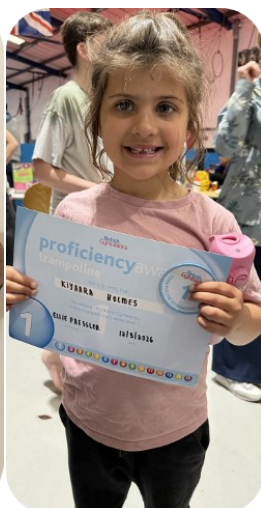

Kiyaan and Kiyaara have passed their stage 1 of trampolining after just two sessions. Well Done!



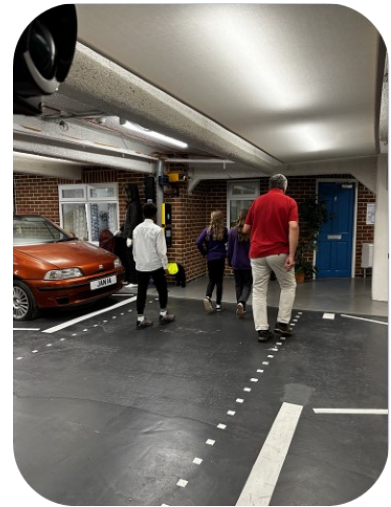
Phoebe has completed stage 7 in swimming. She has made fantastic progress over the last 2 years and we are so proud of her. Well Done!
