Our children in Acorns have been making a splash with their fun swimming session this week! It was also a pleasure to welcome PCSO Jack, who spent time with both Acorns and our Nurture group, helping the children learn more about staying safe in our community and what a great job the Police do. They even got to see a police van! Year 2 have had an extremely busy week! They represented the school wonderfully during their class assemblies, showing great confidence and pride in their learning. In addition, their visit to Redcatch Community Garden provided a fantastic opportunity to explore the outdoors. Year 5 have enjoyed a wide range of enriching experiences. Their Aerospace trip was a real highlight, sparking curiosity and enthusiasm for science and engineering. 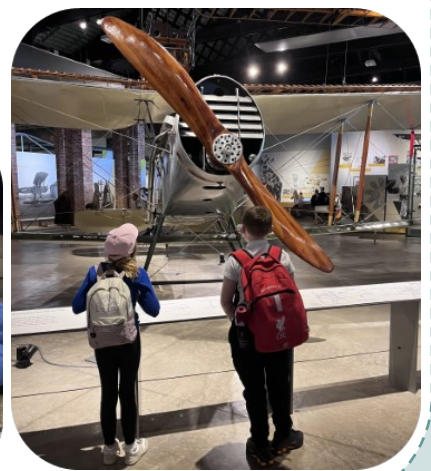
Well Done, Theo & Edie !
