Christmas Nativities and Performances

Arrangements for St Nicholas', St Matthew's and St Mark's joint Nativity and St Luke's and St John's Christmas performance.

This year, the children will be performing twice to allow as many people to see the performances as possible.

Nursery pupils who only attend school on Mondays -Wednesday morning will only be in the first Nativity performance. Nursery pupils who attend on Wednesday pm - Friday will only attend the second Nativity performance.

The first Nativity for St Nicholas', St Matthew's and St Mark's will take place at 2:40pm on Tuesday 9th December and the second Nativity performance will take place at 9:15am on Thursday 11th December. There will be 124 tickets available for each performance.

The first Christmas Performance for St Luke's and St John's will take place at 2:40pm on Monday 15th December and the second Christmas Performance will take place at 9:15am on Tuesday 16th December. There will be 124 tickets available for each performance.

Families are entitled to 4 tickets in total. Families can choose whether they would like all 4 tickets for one performance, OR 2 tickets for each performance. Tickets will be given out on a first come- first serve basis for each performance.

Please note that tickets are FREE of charge and will be available until 12pm the day before each performance.

If you would like 1 extra ticket, we can add your name to a waiting list and if there are any spare tickets available, these will be allocated after 12pm the day before the performance.

Please note, there will be no guarantee of spare tickets. Again, the waiting list will be on a first come-first serve basis.
