

### Can I apply for free school meals?

You can apply for school meals if you receive:


- Income Support or Income Based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance
  - Child Tax Credit with an annual income of less than £16,190, provided they are not receiving Working Tax Credit
- the 'Guaranteed' element of the State Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income threshold of less than £7,400

Please send your child/children to school in their PE kit on their PE days (green boxes in the table below). Please ensure that this is a plain red t-shirt/polo shirt with black shorts/leggings/tracksuit bottoms and either a black tracksuit top or school jumper/cardigan. Please bring the PE kit in a bag, if it doesn't follow our uniform requirements; your child will then be able to change before the PE lesson. Thank you.

### **School Uniform**

Uniform is an important part of a school's identity. It reinforces who we are as a community and helps allow students to feel pride in their school UNIFORM DOES NOT HAVE TO INCLUDE THE SCHOOL'S LOGO.

We have a number of interpretations of what is and is not acceptable uniform, especially PE uniform and we believe it is time to clarify our expectations for students and parents. The uniform policy is available on the website for further reference, but please see the additional guidance below:

#### Uniform for pupils in Reception and Years 1-6:

Shirt Jade green polo shirt, with or without school logo

Skirt/trousers/shorts Grey (or navy) Sweatshirt/cardigan/jumper Navy blue, with or without school logo Summer Dress

Green or blue checked school dress

Socks Plain white, navy or grey Tights Plain white, navy or grey Footwear Indoor: black traditional pumps.

Outdoor: black, sensible, plain school shoes.

Sensible, warm, waterproof outdoor coat appropriate for school wear. Expensive items are worn at own risk. **Outdoor Clothing**

#### **PE Clothing**

Pupils in Reception and in Years 1-6 are expected to have a full change of clothing to participate in Physical Education. For indoor work children can wear pumps or may participate in bare feet. Children can wear school PE kit to school on PE days. Children who do not have the correct PE kit must bring their clothes in a bag to change into.

### Holidays in term time

We have already received requests for holidays in term time during this first week back in school!

From August 2024, the fine for school absences across the country will be £80 if paid within 21 days, or £160 if paid within 28 days. In the case of repeated fines, if a parent receives a second fine for the same child within any three-year period, this will be charged at the higher rate of £160. Fines per parent will be capped to two fines within any three-year period. Once this limit has been reached, other action like a parenting order or prosecution will be considered.

If you're prosecuted and attend court because your child hasn't been attending school, you could get a fine of up to £2,500.

Money raised via fines is only used by the local authority to cover the costs of administering the system, and to fund attendance support. Any extra money is returned to the government. The money is not given to school.

We hope that you will look at the calendar on the school website for 2024-25 to check when our school holidays are planned before booking your holiday or trip abroad. Please make sure you make an appointment to see Mrs Speak after having completed the request form.

### OPEN DOORS EVENT w/c 8th September 2025


We hope you will be able to join us for the Open Doors event. It's an opportunity to informally meet your child's teacher and staff team and for your child to show you their new classroom.

Parking: We have already received a complaints from a resident after being back in school for 1 day!

PLEASE BE CONSIDERATE. As I have said previously, the complaints come to me, taking up time which should be used on the education of your children. It is negatively impacting the reputation of Poplars Farm Primary School.

It has been commented on parents must:

- Not park on the yellow zig zags or double yellow lines (this is illegal)
- Use the mini roundabout to turn direction, not make 3 point turns at the place of parking (this causes congestion and is dangerous).
- Not block residents' driveways.
- Contact the Police if you have been verbally or physically abused by a road user. There is no place for swearing and physical behaviour outside a school with children around.
- We have had many cars damaged in the past, with 2 written off due to irresponsible drivers. Ask school to check CCTV footage if this happens to you.

To those who follow the rules of the road and park safely, apologies for the moan!

We believe that recent changes by the Council have not helped the situation, it is even a tighter squeeze for cars to pass each other. Please contact the Council if you feel the same, thank you.

### Wraparound Care - Breakfast Club and Afterschool Club::

Breakfast Club is for pupils in Nursery (ONLY 4 years old and above), Reception to Year 6. It runs daily from 7.45am until the start of school. Our After School Club runs daily for pupils from Reception to Year 6 from 3:15pm until 6pm.

Children who are in receipt of PPG are attend the breakfast club at no cost.

If you would like your child to attend the afterschool club provision starting from 5 September 2023, please email the school office, office@poplarsfarm.bradford.sch.uk stating your child/children's names, classes and dates you would like your child to attend the provision including their pick up times.

Please note that if your child or children's Parent Pay account does not have sufficient funds for them to attend the breakfast and afterschool club, we will not be able to offer them a place.

Breakfast Club – 7:45am – Start of School

- £1.50 per session which includes breakfast

(FSM children no charge, this does not include UIFSM)

Afterschool Club – 15:15pm – 16:30pm collection - £4.00 per session which includes a drink and light snack

Afterschool Club – 15:15pm up to 18:00pm collection - £6.00 per session which includes tea

Our charges still remain much lower than other provisions!

For our newer parents, the Parents' What's App group OR ANY SPECIFIC CLASS GROUP are NOT linked to school directly.




