

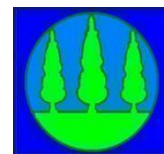

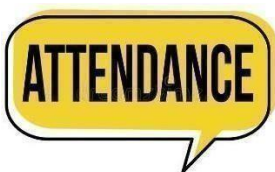


Team Merit Points

Our current overall leading team is RSPB with 91,200 points and this week's winning team is – Wildlife Trust with 4,800 points. Well Done!



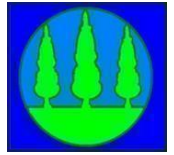

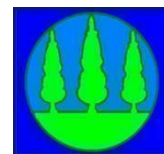
We raised a huge **£324.40**. THANK YOU!

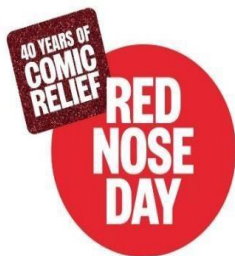

Reception and KS1 (Year 1 and Year 2) children may bring to school their party clothes to change into at the end of the day and collections will be at classroom doors.

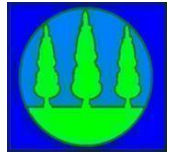

Kids With Bricks After School Club at Poplars Farm Primary School

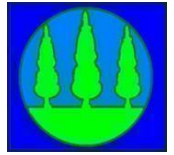
We are pleased to be able to offer our Kids With Bricks after school club running from 3:20 - 4:15 every Monday for 5 weeks from 13th April 2026 (No club 4th May- Bank Holiday). 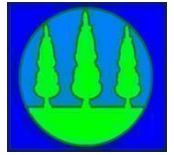

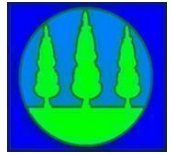

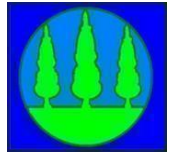
Wraparound Care - Breakfast Club and Afterschool

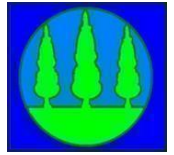

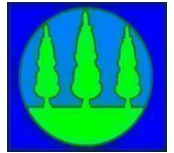

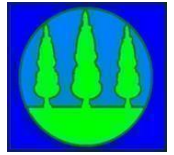
